

Jeremy Farber Baseball Bio

Coach Farber currently serves as the head coach of the Alamo Drillers select team, which is comprised of players from south Texas in the class of 2023. He has led the Drillers since 2017. Previously he led the McAllister Park Little League all stars to a Texas West state championship in 2016 as 11 year olds, and in 2017 a state championship and a runner-up finish in the Southwest Regional in Waco, Texas. The only team to beat them that summer was Texas East, who advanced to the Little League World Series in Williamsport and won the US bracket.
