



CORNER COMMUNITY PARK TRAVEL TOURNAMENT

BASEBALL TEAM POLICY

1. Travel Tournament teams will begin at 7u and older. Ages 5 and 6 are not allowed to play on a tournament team.
2. Travel Tournament Team Head Coaches shall be selected and approved by the Baseball Commissioner and at least one (1) Board Member prior to tryouts. Head Coach can select their own Assistant Coaches as long as they are in good standing with the Park.
3. A **maximum** of 1 tournament team practice per week during the park baseball season. Tournament teams will be allowed two (2) practices the week of a scheduled tournament only.
4. Coaches must schedule a **minimum** of 1 tournament per month for the months of March, April and May.
5. Corner Community Park Travel Tournament Team Uniform Policy shall include matching hats, jerseys, pants, and socks only. There will be no player names allowed on the uniforms. No travel tournament team will be allowed to have any other matching equipment such as, but not limited to, bat bags, helmets, shoes etc.
6. Any travel tournament team fundraisers associated with Corner Community Park must be approved by the Corner Community Park Board prior to the sanctioned event. Fundraising activities that compete with the concession stand and other Corner Community Park events will not be allowed at the park. Any person in violation of this stated Section could be subject to their child being ineligible to play at Corner Community Park.
7. The Travel Tournament team will be restricted to no more than twelve (12) players.
8. Tryouts must be held and every interested child must be in attendance unless otherwise approved by the Board.
9. Board must have written approval from Parents/Guardians for their child to play on team prior to tryouts. No exceptions.
10. Baseball Commissioner, at least one (1) other Board Member, and Head Coach is required to attend tryouts. Substitutions can be granted.
11. Selection of players shall be determined by the Baseball Commissioner, at least one (1) other Board Member, and Head Coach in a meeting after the tryout.
